- Proper Mounting:** Ensure the switch is mounted securely and aligned with the busbars and MCBs to maintain reliable electrical connections.
- Check Clearances:** Maintain adequate spacing between components to prevent overheating and allow easy access for maintenance.

- Plan the Layout:** Identify the position of the main switch and output MCBs within the box.
- Mark Drill Points:** Use a pencil or marker to indicate where holes are needed for mounting screws or cable entry.
