AI Overview

El Salvador is deploying its first submarine fiber optic cable using OS2 single-mode fiber to enhance long-distance, high-speed connectivity and digital infrastructure resilience. Overview of the Project El Salvador currently relies exclusively on terrestrial links through neighboring countries, which limits bandwidth, increases costs, and reduces reliability. To address this, the government, through its telecom regulator SIGET, has contracted Liberty Networks to design, construct, and operate the country's first submarine cable. The new 1,800 km system will connect El Salvador to major international hubs, significantly boosting internet capacity and resiliency for the nation's 6.3 million citizens, with operations expected by the second half of 2028 . The project includes building a landing station, secure submarine cables, interconnection systems between ground stations and the submarine cable, and acquiring high-end equipment for data reception and power generation. It also strengthens institutional capacity at SIGET through training, consultancy, and technological upgrades, improving the regulatory and operational framework for telecommunications .

Why OS2 Fiber is Chosen OS2 is a single-mode fiber optimized for long-distance and outdoor applications, making it ideal for submarine and intercity deployments. Compared to OS1, OS2 offers lower attenuation and better performance over extended distances, supporting high-speed data transmission across hundreds or thousands of kilometers . Key advantages include:

- Long-range capability:** OS2 can maintain signal integrity over tens of kilometers without repeaters, essential for submarine cables.
- High bandwidth:** Supports modern high-speed networks, including 10Gbps, 40Gbps, and beyond.
- Durability:** Designed for outdoor and harsh environments, with dual-layer protective coatings and water-resi...
