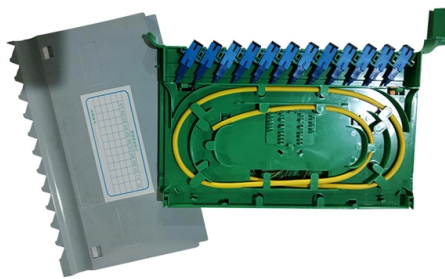

- Protective Relays:** Detect abnormal conditions and command breakers to operate, ensuring rapid fault isolation.
- Busbars:** Conduct and distribute electrical power within the switchgear system.
- Earthing Switches:** Safely discharge residual currents to ground during maintenance.
- Control Panels & Indicators:** Interface for monitoring, operation, and fault management.

Types of High Voltage Switchgear

- Air Insulated Switchgear (AIS):** Uses atmospheric air as the insulating medium. It is cost-effective and suitable for outdoor or spacious installations but requires more maintenance due to environmental exposure.
- Gas Insulated Switchgear (GIS):** Uses SF_6 gas for insulation, allowing a compact design ideal for urban or space-constrained areas. GIS is highly reliable and low-maintenance but more expensive and has environmental considerations due to SF_6 ...
