

Electrification box obstructing the staircase

Placing an electrification box on or obstructing a staircase is generally not allowed due to safety and egress requirements, and alternative locations or enclosures should be considered.

Safety and Code Considerations Electrical consumer units or boxes under stairs must not obstruct the staircase or egress path. Stairways are considered critical exit routes, and any obstruction can create a tripping hazard or impede emergency evacuation. Material choice matters: metal boxes are preferred for larger cables (e.g., 25mm SWA), while plastic boxes may be used if strong enough to avoid cracking or stress from cable glands.

Fire and Electrical Safety Any panel under a stairwell must respect fire-rated wall requirements if the stairwell is part of a rated exit enclosure. Transformers or low-voltage equipment under stairs should be reviewed by a code authority to ensure they do not compromise fire safety or violate occupancy rules.

Regular inspection and maintenance of the consumer unit are essential to ensure proper operation and protection against electrical faults.

Practical Solutions Relocate the box to a nearby wall or cupboard that does not interfere with the staircase. Recess the box into the wall under the stairs to maintain clearance. Use a compact or custom enclosure designed for under-stair spaces, ensuring it meets electrical and fire safe...
