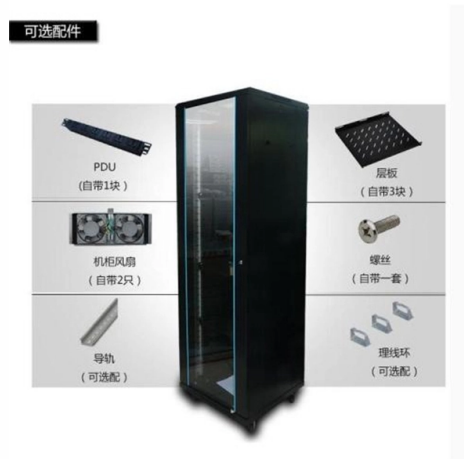


Emergency stop wiring of distribution box

An emergency stop (E-stop) switch is wired using normally closed (NC) contacts in series with the control circuit to immediately cut power to the load when pressed. Key Components and Function An E-stop switch is a safety device designed to instantly disconnect power from machinery or equipment during emergencies. Most E-stops have NC contacts for power control and sometimes NO contacts for indicator circuits like buzzers or lights. The NC contacts remain closed under normal operation, allowing current to flow, and open when the button is pressed, breaking the circuit and stopping the machine. Wiring Procedure Power Off: Always disconnect the main power supply before starting any wiring. Identify Terminals: Most E-stops have four terminals: two NC and two NO. NC terminals are used for the load circuit, while NO terminals are optional for indicators. Connect NC Contacts: Wire the NC terminals in series with the contactor coil or control circuit. This ensures that pressing the E-stop opens the circuit and deactivates the contactor, cutting power to the load. Optional NO Contacts: If using indicator devices, connect the NO terminals to the buzzer or light circuit. These activate when the E-stop is pressed. Secure Connections: Ensure all wires are properly insulated and terminals are tightened to prevent loose connections. Series Wiring for Multiple E-stops: In high-safety applications, multiple E-stops can be wired in series so that pressing any button interrupts the circuit. Integration with Distribution Box Place the E-stop switch in a readily accessible location on the distribution box or near the machinery. Connect the E-stop in series with the main contactor or relay controlling the load. The contactor's power input is connected to the main supply, and its output goes to the machine or equipment. Include fuses or circuit breakers as required to protect the wiring and components. Testing and Safety After wiring, restore power and press the E-stop to verify that the machine stops immediately. Test the reset function by twisting or pu...
