- Rejoining Side Walls:** After bending, side cuts are rejoined using welding, bolting, or riveting with reinforcement strips to maintain structural integrity.

Wire Mesh Tray Bends: For wire mesh trays, bends, tees, and reducers can be made on-site using bolt cutters, which preserve the protective zinc layer and allow live adjustments.
