- Fixing Method:** Securely mount using brackets or screws to prevent movement due to vibration or collisions .
- Wiring Specifications:** Use high-temperature resistant copper wires with cross-sectional areas suitable for load current. Ensure neat cable management, proper insulation, and no exposed conductors .
- Protection Devices:** Each circuit should have its own breaker, fuse, or s...
