- Optical Performance:** Using single-mode fibers with wavelengths of 1310 or 1550 nm, ADSS cables can support long-distance transmission (up to 100 km without repeaters) and high fiber counts (up to 864 fibers per cable), ensuring low attenuation and reliable signal quality.
- Variants:** ADSS cables may include standard, aramid-reinforced, armored, or double-jacketed versions, tailored for specific span lengths, environmental conditions, and mechanical stress requirements.
