Installation Best Practices

- Maintain Minimum Bend Radius:** Avoid sharp bends; the cable should not be bent below the manufacturer's recommended radius, typically 10–20 times the cable diameter depending on tension.
- Figure-8 Loops:** When laying cable on surfaces or during pull-in, use figure-8 loops to prevent twisting and maintain fiber integrity.
- Clamping Intervals:** For vertical or aerial installations, clamps should be spaced frequently enough to support the cable weight and prevent movement, ensuring long-term stability.
- Tension Management:** Do not exceed the cable's maximum pulling tension. Use tension clamps or hand-guided banding tools to secure cables without over-tightening.
- Protective Measures:** Keep protective sheaths in place until installation is complete, and avoid contact with sharp objects or edges that could damage the cable.
