- 5. Cable Jacket**The cable jacket is the outer layer of the fiber optic cable. It protects the internal components from environmental hazards, such as moisture, chemicals, and physical damage. The jacket is made from durable materials, often PVC or other weather-resistant substances, depending on the cable's intended use. These five components work together to ensure that fiber optic cables can transmit data efficiently and reliably over long distances, making them essential for modern communication systems .
