

Fiber Optic Cable Installation Standards and Requirements

Safety Requirements Technicians must follow strict safety protocols: Eye protection to prevent injury from fiber shards. Proper handling of fiber scraps to avoid contamination or injury. Underground utility location before trenching to prevent accidental damage. Compliance with OSHA regulations and manufacturer safety instructions.

Cable Handling and Installation Maintain the minimum bend radius specified by the manufacturer to prevent fiber breakage. Avoid exceeding the maximum pulling tension; never pull directly on the fibers. Use figure-8 loops when laying cable to prevent twisting and mechanical stress. Protect cables from sharp edges, rocks, and mechanical pressure, especially for LSZH or armored cables. Keep protective material on reels until installation to prevent damage.

Routing and Clearances Outside plant cables may be installed underground, aerial, or in ducts, with proper clearances from power lines and other utilities. Minimum clearances: 18 feet above roads and 40 inches from energized conductors on utility poles. Grounding and bonding must follow standards to prevent electrical hazards.

Cable Types and Markings Select cables based on fiber type, construction, and flammability rating for the environment (OSP vs. premises). Proper color coding and labeling are essential...
