They are less common in modern high-density data centers but remain important for maintaining existing infrastructure.

Overview of LC Connectors The LC (Lucent Connector) is a miniaturized connector with a 1.25 mm ferrule and a push-pull latch mechanism, allowing for high port density in patch panels and transceiver cages . LC connectors are the de facto standard for SFP/SFP+ and QSFP transceivers and are widely used in data centers, telecom networks, and high-density fiber installations . LC connectors are available in UPC (Ultra Physical Contact) and APC (Angled Physical Contact) polish types, with APC variants providing very low return loss for applications like PON backbones .
