

Fiber Optic Cable Laying Reel Laying Method

Fiber optic cables should be deployed from reels using controlled figure-8 or straight payout sequences, maintaining minimum bend radius and proper tension to prevent damage.

Reel Preparation and Handling Before deployment, inspect the reel for structural integrity, ensuring flange bolts are tight and the drum is free of debris that could damage the cable. Use a forklift or reel mover with forks perpendicular to the reel axis, never lifting from the tail-flange side to avoid crushing the cable. Laying Sequence

Initial Setup: Cut the cable tail to about one foot and leave it unsecured to allow free payout.

Figure-8 Pattern: Lay the cable in a figure-8 pattern on a tarp or flat surface to prevent kinking and maintain symmetry. Each loop should be slightly offset from the previous to reduce mechanical stress.

Controlled Payout: During installation, maintain consistent tension using a tension-controlled reel or drum brake. Avoid over-spinning the reel or letting the cable “squirt” out uncontrolled, which can cause reverse squirt and wavy layers.

Bend Radius Compliance: Never bend the cable below its minimum bend radius during payout. After installation, the cable may be bent to the long-term application bend radius, but not sharper.

Intermediate Supports: For vertical or long horizontal runs, clamp the cable at intervals to prevent excessive tension from its own weight.

Deployment Considerations

Avoid Obstacles: Ensure the route is free of sharp edges, uneven terrain, or machinery that could damage the cable.

Environmental Protection: Keep fiber away from high temperatures, metallic power cables, or other hazards.

Reel Monitoring: Never leave the let-off reel unattended during a pull to prevent uncontrolled tension or cable damage.
