- GYTA (Underground/Duct Armored Cable):** 48-core single-mode with corrosion-resistant steel tape, suitable for underground deployment.
- GYXTW (Lightweight Armored Cable):** 12-core, cost-effective for rural and remote areas.

These cables are designed to withstand Zambia's climate and provide reliable connectivity for both telecom operators and enterprise networks.
