

Fiber Optic Router Shutdown

Step 4: Disconnect AC Power Turn off the circuit or power supply connected to the router. Unplug the router's AC power cable from the wall outlet or power strip. Wait at least 60 seconds to ensure the router fully powers down and temporary settings or errors dissipate.

Step 5: Optional Precautions Avoid frequent power cycling, as repeated abrupt shutdowns can stress hardware over time. If performing maintenance or firmware updates, ensure the router is fully powered down before reconnecting power. For security purposes, powering off the router can reduce exposure to network vulnerabilities. By following these steps, your fiber optic router will be completely shut down, including any backup power sources, ensuring safe maintenance or trou...
