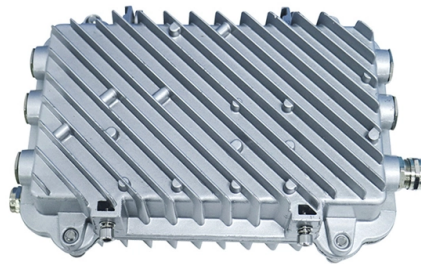

4. Cable Management Accessories Management rings, guides, and holders help maintain bend radius, prevent fiber damage, and organize multiple fibers within the enclosure. These accessories are particularly important in high-density installations to avoid signal degradation.
5. Mounting Kits and Enclosures Terminal boxes can be wall-mounted, pole-mounted, or installed indoors/outdoors. Accessories include brackets, pole-mount kits, and weatherproof gaskets for IP65/IP68-rated enclosures. These ensure secure installation and environmental protection.
6. Heat-Shrink Sleeves and Protective Tubing Used to protect spliced fibers and maintain mechanical integrity, heat-shrink sleeves and tubing prevent fiber breakage and environmental damage.
