Ensure both devices are in a dry, ventilated area with surge protection. For advanced setups, some routers support SFP/SFP+ modules for direct fiber input, bypassing the ONT in certain configurations. By following these steps, your fiber optic adapter and router setup will deliver reliable, high-speed internet suitable for streaming, gaming, and other bandwidth-intensive applications.
