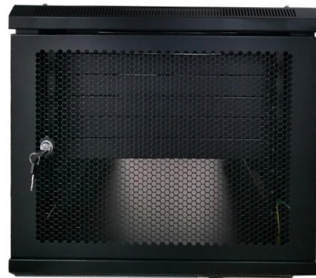


Fiber optic cable and ground wire sag
