- ST (Straight Tip):** Uses a bayonet-style twist-lock; suitable for legacy or industrial networks but less common in modern drop-in setups.
- FC (Ferrule Connector):** Threaded design for high-vibration environments; ideal for instrumentation or long-distance networks.
- MPO/MTP:** Supports multiple fibers in a single connection; used in high-bandwidth data centers but may be overkill for simple drop-in applications.
