- Locate Breaks:** For long runs, OTDR testing can pinpoint breaks or high-attenuation points.
- Preventive Measures**
 - Routine Maintenance:** Inspect drop cables every 6–12 months, even if no issues are apparent.
 - Proper Installation:** Use bend-insensitive fibers (G.657.A2) for tight indoor corners and ensure correct routing to avoid sharp bends.
 - Protective Measures:** For underground or ducted installations, use round or toneable drop cables with aramid yarn for strength and waterproofing.
 - Environmental Protection:** Shield outdoor cables from UV exposure and moisture ingress, and consider messenger wires for aerial spans.
