- Center the Splice** If using a clear sleeve or protective splice tube, center the fiber splice within the tubing. This allows for proper sealing and visual inspection before heating.
- Apply Heat Evenly** Using a hot air gun or butane torch, heat the tubing evenly while rotating the cable. Move the heat source back and forth to ensure uniform shrinkage. Avoid overheating, which can damage the fiber or tubing.
- Allow Cooling** After the tubing has fully shrunk and formed a tight seal, allow it to cool completely before handling or positioning the cable for use. This ensures a secure, moisture-resistant connection.
- Secure and Organize** If applicable, place the protected cable into a splice tray or secure it with cable ties or tape to prevent strain on the splice. Ensure the cable maintains the mi...
