

Fireproofing and wall-penetrating cable trays

Cable trays passing through walls or slabs must be firestopped using approved materials and methods to maintain fire integrity and prevent smoke or flame propagation.

Firestopping Principles When cable trays penetrate walls, floors, or slabs, all openings must be tightly sealed with fire-resistant materials to comply with safety standards and maintain the structural fire rating of the barrier. Firestopping ensures that in the event of a fire, flames, heat, and smoke do not spread through penetrations, protecting both personnel and equipment.

Key Requirements:

- Sealing Materials:** Use fire-rated boards, firestop packs, firestop mastic, or mineral wool. Gaps between cables and firestop packs should not exceed 1 cm², and packing thickness should be at least 24 cm.
- Backing Plates:** For large openings, install a fire-resistant backing plate before sealing to provide structural support and ensure complete coverage.
- Cover Plates:** Use square, evenly painted cover plates to close openings, ensuring a neat and reliable seal.
- Intumescent Products:** Firestop caulks and putties, such as 3M Fire Barrier Moldable Putty+ or IC 15WB Caulk, expand under heat to block flames and smoke while protecting cable trays.

- Reserved Openings:** Plan and reserve openings in walls or slabs before cable tray installation to facilitate proper firestopping.
- Cable Routing:** Install cable trays along the shortest, straightest path, segregating power and signal cables to reduce interference and simplify fireproofing.
- Firestop Systems:** Modular systems like FIRSTO or NOFIRNO allow sealing around multiple cables or pipes, providing fire, water, and gas protection.
- Retrofit Solutions:** Quick-install devices and self-compressing plugs (e.g., SLIPSIL) can be used for existing penetrations without dismantling the cable tray.
