- Router Configuration** Access the router's admin panel via a web browser (commonly 192.168.0.1 or 192.168.1.1). Enter ISP credentials if required. Enable Quality of Service (QoS) for prioritizing critical traffic like VoIP or video conferencing.
- Update firmware** on both the router and ONT to ensure optimal performance.
- Testing and Optimization** Verify the connection speed using speed tests to confirm gigabit performance. Use wired connections for latency-sensitive applications. Secure your Wi-Fi network with strong passwords and consider Wi-Fi 6/7 routers to fully leverage fiber speeds.
- Advanced Considerations** GBIC/SFP Modules: Hot-swappable devices that allow fiber connections to switches or routers. Ensure the module type matches your fiber (multi-mode or single-mode) and distance requirements.
