- Optical Network Terminal (ONT):** Converts incoming light signals into electrical signals for your network. Typically installed near the fiber entry point in a home or office.
- Fiber-Ready Router:** Supports gigabit or multi-gigabit speeds. Modern routers with Wi-Fi 6 or higher standards maximize network performance.
- Ethernet Cable:** High-quality Cat6a or better cables connect the ONT to the router, preserving gigabit speeds.
- Transceivers and Media Converters:** SFP or SFP+ modules allow flexible connections between fiber and Ethernet networks, enabling distance extension and network segmentation.

Installation Steps

- Plan the Network Path:** Conduct a site survey to identify endpoints, equipment rooms, and potential obstacles. Leave extra conduit space for future expansion.
- Select Cable Type:** Choose single-mode or multi-mode fiber based on distance and bandwidth requirements. Consider armored cables for high-risk environments.
- Install Fiber Cable:** Route and secure cables carefully, avoiding sharp bends or excessive tension. Follow industry standards like ANSI/NECA/FOA-301 and TIA/EIA-568.
- Terminate and Test:** Use proper connectors (e.g., SC/APC) and test each link for signal integrity and performance.
