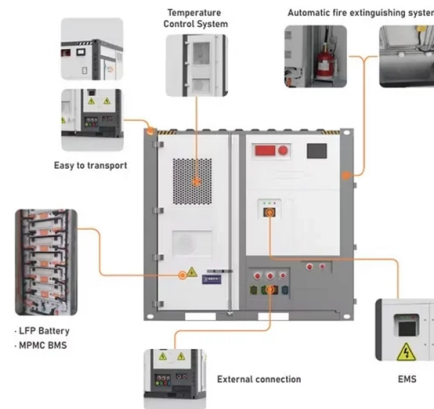

It also promotes universal energy access, particularly in energy-poor regions, by providing reliable and clean electricity.
