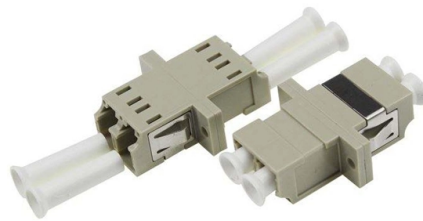


# Hard wire for grounding of distribution box

A distribution box must be grounded using appropriately sized copper wires connected from the box to a central grounding point to ensure safety and compliance. Grounding Wire Selection In the US, use a 10 AWG (5.26 mm<sup>2</sup>) copper wire for grounding the distribution box. In other markets, a 6 mm<sup>2</sup> copper wire is typically required. For connections between mounting plates and equipment like spindle plates, larger wires may be needed (e.g., 6 AWG / 13.29 mm<sup>2</sup>) to maintain low resistance and proper grounding. Mounting Plate to Central Ground: Connect a second ground wire from the mounting plate to the factory or building's central grounding point. Internal Components: All metal parts and electrical components inside the box that require grounding should be connected to the PE (Protective Earth) bus inside the box. Metal Conduits: Any metal threading or conduit connected to the box should also be electrically bonded to the box, either by welding or using approved connectors. Installation Steps Use a green hexagonal grounding screw or a listed grounding lug to attach the grounding conductor to the metal box. Ensure the screw bites through any paint or coating to make a solid electrical connection to bare metal. Connect a grounding pigtail (short copper wire) from the screw to the PE bus or main grounding system. All incoming and outgoing ground wires must be joined together using approved connectors or wire nuts to maintain continuity. Resistance and Safety The total ground resistance between all system parts should be less than 0.1 Ohm.
