The top edge of guardrails for fixed distribution boxes should be 42 inches (± 3 inches) above the walking or working surface, with midrails installed midway between the top rail and the surface. Additional Considerations Toe boards: At least 3.5 inches tall to prevent objects from falling. Material and strength: Guardrails must be constructed from materials capable of withstanding heavy impacts without deflection that compromises safety. Special conditions: If employees use stilts or elevated equipment, the top rail height should be increased accordingly. In summary, for fixed distribution boxes, a top rail height of 42 inches (± 3 inches) with a midrail at 21 inches meets OSHA and international safety standards, ensuring adequate fall protection and compliance.
