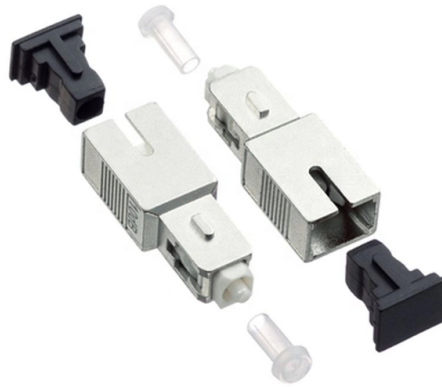

- Surge Protection Devices (SPDs):** Protect sensitive electronics from voltage spikes.

- Placement:** Install in a dry, accessible area at about 1.5 meters from the floor for easy access and safety.
- Wiring:** Ensure proper grounding, correct wire gauge, neat cable management, and secure connections.
