Tighten bolts or screws according to manufacturer specifications to prevent movement. Ensure that all fasteners are compatible with the tray material (steel, aluminum, or FRP) to avoid galvanic corrosion.

Maintain Grounding and Bonding

Ensure electrical continuity across the joint by connecting bonding jumpers or using conductive splice plates. Proper grounding prevents electrical hazards and complies with NEC Article 392 requirements.

Check Support Spacing

Horizontal runs must be supported at intervals specified by the manufacturer, typically using trapeze hangers or wall-mounted brackets. Overhanging or unsupported sections can lead to sagging and cable damage.
