Horizontal cable trays with angles use elbows and bend fittings to route cables smoothly while maintaining structural support and minimizing stress on cables. Types of Angled Fittings

1. Horizontal Elbows: Available in standard angles such as 30° and 90° for channel or ladder trays. Aluminum channel elbows often come with pre-punched holes for easy cable attachment without drilling, reducing labor and speeding installation. Ladder tray elbows, like the Legrand ltray/90HB, feature smooth transitions and structural offsets for strong mid-span splices, allowing fewer supports and faster installation.
2. Tees and Crosses: Used to split or merge cable runs horizontally. Tees include two connectors, and crosses include three, typically supplied with hardware for secure installation.
3. Adjustable or Modular Bends: Some systems allow custom bending of wire mesh or tubing trays to achieve specific angles, providing flexibility for complex layouts.

Materials and Construction

- Aluminum:** Lightweight, corrosion-resistant, ideal for industrial or long-span installations.
- Steel (Ladder Tray):** Tubular steel construction provides mechanical support and strain relief, suitable for heavy cable bundles in data centers or equipment rooms.
- Wire Mesh or Tubing Trays:** Allow ventilation, easy access, and stress relief for cables and hoses.

Installation Considerations

- Bend Radius:** Ensure elbows and bends maintain a radius that prevents cable damage. Standard elbows often specify a bend radius (e.g., 12 in for 90° ltray elbow).
- Support Spacing:** Follow manufacturer guidelines; ladder trays and tubing trays typically require supports every 6 feet or as specified for load class.
- Modularity:** Many systems are modular, allowing easy addition of elbows, tees, and straight sections without extensive rework.
- Hardware Efficiency:** Modern designs reduce the number of bolts or connectors needed, speeding installation and reducing material costs.
