Vertical cable managers (VCMs) can be installed alongside vertical trays to guide and protect cables during the transition from horizontal to vertical runs. Support and Installation Supports: Both horizontal and vertical trays require proper support, such as wall brackets, trapeze hangers, or ceiling mounts, to maintain alignment and prevent sagging. Alignment: Ensure the horizontal tray aligns with the vertical tray before securing fittings. This prevents cable strain and maintains proper bend radius. Material Compatibility: Use trays and fittings made from compatible materials (e.g., aluminum or steel) to avoid galvanic...

90° horizontal bends ... G – Vertical bend without a radius (90°) create a 90° vertical bend, remove one section of side wires on each side of the tray at the point where the angle is required and bend into
