- Connect Tray Sections:** Use couplers or connectors to join multiple tray sections. Ensure all joints are tight and aligned to prevent sagging or misalignment.
- Check Load and Clearance:** Verify that the installed tray can support the intended cable load and that there is sufficient clearance for maintenance and other trades.
- Secure Cables:** Once the tray is installed, lay cables and secure them according to electrical codes and manufacturer recommendations. Avoid overloading the tray.
