Install GFCI Protection: As a temporary or supplementary measure, Ground Fault Circuit Interrupters (GFCIs) can be installed at outlets or breakers. GFCIs trip when they detect current leakage, providing shock protection even without a true ground, but outlets must be labeled "No Equipment Ground". Avoid Bootleg Grounds: Connecting the neutral to the ground screw at an outlet is illegal and dangerous.
