Circuit Configuration and Power Ratings

- Main Switch / Main MCB:** Controls the entire household supply. In single-phase domestic systems, the main MCB is typically rated around 63A for standard homes, handling the total load from all circuits.
- Branch Circuit Breakers:** Each room or appliance group has its own MCB. Common configurations include:
 - Room socket circuits:** 6–16A single-pole MCBs for general outlets.
 - Lighting circuits:** 6–10A MCBs to ensure stable operation.
 - High-power appliances:** 16–32A or higher double-pole MCBs for stoves, water heaters, or air conditioners.
- RCCB / RCD:** Provides protection against earth leakage, preventing electric shocks. The total circuit power is determined by the sum of the rated capacities of all branch circuits, but the main MCB must be sized to handle the expected maximum load safely. For example, a home with multiple high-power appliances may require a higher-rated main MCB or even a three-phase supply in larger homes.

- Single-phase supply:** Common in domestic homes, typically 230V AC in many countries, with phase and neutral wires connected to the main MCB.
- Grounding:** All circuits include a grounding wire to divert fault currents safely to earth.
- Subpanels:** For large homes, subpanels may be installed to manage circuits in specific areas, each with its own set of breakers.
