Circuit Breakers: Protect individual circuits from overloads and short circuits. Types include: 1P (Single Pole): Controls only the live wire. 1P+N (Single Pole + Neutral): Protects both live and neutral wires. 2P (Double Pole): Provides maximum safety by isolating both live and neutral wires ().

Bus Bars: Conduct electricity to multiple circuits efficiently.

Fuses: In older systems, used instead of breakers to protect circuits.

Indication Lights: Show the status of mains power and circuit operation ().

Optional Smart Modules: Energy monitoring units and communication modules for real-time data and home automation integration ().

Circuit Configuration A well-designed household distribution box typically includes:

Room Socket Circuits: Separate circuits for each room to isolate electrical issues.

High-Power Appliance Circuits: Dedicated circuits for appliances like air conditioners, stoves, and water heaters.

Lighting Circuits: Independent circuits to ensure lighting remains operational even if other circuits fail ().

Types of Distribution Boxes

Main Distribution Board (MDB): Central control unit receiving power from the main supply and feeding sub-distribution boards or end circuits ().

Sub Distribution Board (SDB): Smaller boards connected to the MDB, distributing power to specific areas.

Fuse Box: Traditional unit used in older homes for circuit protection.
