Switch Boxes Switch boxes are enclosures that house electrical switches, outlets, or junctions. They are installed flush or surface-mounted and come in various sizes and IP ratings depending on the environment . Common types include:

- Flush-Mounted Switch Boxes:** Installed inside walls for a clean finish.
- Surface-Mounted Switch Boxes:** Mounted on the wall surface, suitable for retrofits.
- Junction Boxes:** Used to connect multiple wires safely, often in humid or wet areas with IP54 or higher ratings.
- Cavity Wall Switch Boxes:** Designed for hollow walls, sometimes with press-out membranes for easy installation .
