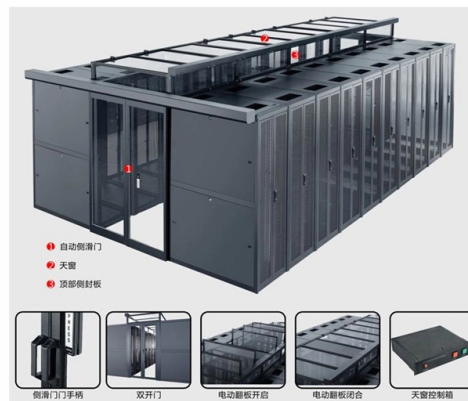


How many circuits should be selected for a home distribution box
