Third-Level Distribution (Tertiary Distribution) The third-level distribution box, also called the lighting power distribution box, is the final junction point before electricity reaches individual appliances or units. It usually operates at mains voltage (220V single-phase) and contains single-phase circuit breakers and leakage protection switches. This level is designed for small-capacity, scattered loads and can be either movable or fixed, ensuring safe and convenient connection to household or office equipment.
