- Small residential or low-capacity boxes: \$500-\$1,000 for aerial installation; \$1,000-\$1,500 for underground installation.
- Medium to large commercial boxes: \$1,500-\$2,500, especially if installed underground or in areas with difficult terrain or high labor costs.
- High-capacity or backbone network boxes: Costs can exceed \$3,000 when including complex splicing, high fiber counts, and additional protective infrastructure.
