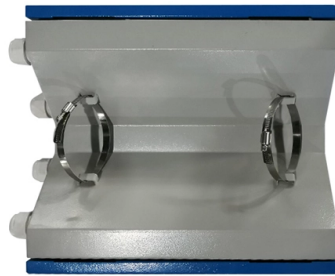


How to adjust the aggregation port of a switch

Port aggregation combines multiple physical ports into a single logical link to increase bandwidth, provide redundancy, and enable load balancing. Key Concepts Port aggregation (also called Link Aggregation or LAG) allows multiple physical ports to act as one logical interface. This can be done in static mode (manual configuration) or dynamic mode using LACP (Link Aggregation Control Protocol), which negotiates aggregation automatically with the connected device. Prerequisites Before configuring aggregation, ensure the following: Consistent port attributes: speed, duplex (full duplex only), and link type (trunk, hybrid, or access) must match across all aggregated ports. VLAN consistency: all ports should have the same permitted VLANs and PVID. STP settings: spanning tree protocol must be consistent (enabled/disabled, priority, cost) across aggregated ports. Port availability: ensure the switch has enough free ports for aggregation. Device compatibility: both ends of the link must support the same aggregation protocol, especially for LACP. Aggregation Modes Static (ON) Mode: Adds ports to a static aggregation group without negotiation. Up to 8 ports can be aggregated. All ports must meet the configuration prerequisites. LACP Active Mode: Ports actively initiate LACP negotiation with the peer device to form a dynamic aggregation group. LACP Passive Mode: Ports wait for the peer device to initiate LACP negotiation. Configuration Steps (General) Verify port settings: Check VLAN, STP, speed, duplex, and link type on all ports intended for aggregation. Remove conflicting configurations: Disable MAC authentication, 802.1X, or port security if present. Create the aggregation group: Assign selected ports to a logical aggregation interface (e.g., Bridge-aggregation or Port-channel) using static or LACP mode. Assign VLANs: Configure the aggregated interface as a trunk or access port a...
