

How to arrange the optical cables in order

Label each cable: Clearly mark both ends with identifiers corresponding to the patch panel or splitter port to simplify maintenance and reduce errors . Route along protective conduits: When using corrugated pipes or innerducts, ensure fibers are not forced or bent excessively .

Cleaning and Handling Clean connectors before plugging: Dust or dirt on fiber end faces can cause signal loss . Pull, don't push: Always pull cables along the path to avoid exceeding bend radius or damaging fibers . Monitor t...
