

How to calculate the quantity of optical fiber cable

4. Calculate Segment LengthsMultiply each segment length by the number of cables required for that segment. Sum all segments to get the base cable length ().
5. Apply Waste FactorAccount for trimming, damaged ends, and handling losses. Adjust the percentage based on site-specific practices and historical performance ().
6. Determine Total Cable QuantityTotal cable length = Base length + Slack + Spare + Waste factor. If ordering reels, divide total length by reel size and round up to the nearest whole reel ().
