

How to connect a 100-meter fiber optic cable

Connector Termination: Attach connectors to each end of the fiber using epoxy or pre-terminated kits. Ensure the connector type matches your router, ONT, or switch ports ().

Step 4: Connect to Devices

Insert the fiber into the router, switch, or ONT port, ensuring the connector clicks securely. Avoid bending the fiber beyond its minimum bend radius to prevent signal degradation. Use cable management tools like velcro straps or trays to secure excess cable and prev...
