Avoid connecting two female inputs to one male output on a 1x2 splitter, as this can cause interference and noise.

Cascading splitters is possible if more outputs are needed, but each additional split increases signal loss, so plan accordingly.

Connector compatibility is crucial: mixing APC and UPC connectors can degrade performance
