

How to connect a router to fiber optic signal

- Check the ONT and router lights: a solid green power light on the ONT indicates proper operation, and the router's WAN light should confirm internet connectivity.

Additional Tips

- Place the ONT and router in a dry, ventilated area near power outlets, ideally with surge protection.
- Avoid bending or stressing the fiber cable, as it is sensitive to damage.
- For larger homes, consider mesh Wi-Fi devices to extend coverage.
