

# How to connect a switch with both optical and electrical ports

This allows full-duplex gigabit transmission without additional configuration, as it acts as a media converter.
- Using Combo Ports:** If the switch has a combo port, choose which interface to use based on your cabling needs. Connect either the RJ45 cable or the SFP module (copper or optical). The switch will automatically disable the unused interface.
- For redundancy,** some switches can detect both connections and assign one as active and the other as backup.
- External Media Converters:** If a copper SFP module is unavailable, an external media converter can bridge RJ45 and fiber connections. This requires power and introduces an additional device in the network, but it is a viable solution for budget or legacy setups.
