

How to connect fiber optic cable to the panel installation

Lubricate the cable if pulling through conduits to reduce friction and stress on the fibers. Monitor the supply reel and communicate with the installation team to prevent cable jumps or snags.

Termination onto the Panel Remove the protective end cap and carefully strip the cable jacket without nicking the fibers. Use the appropriate connector type (LC, SC, or ST) for the panel. If splicing is required, perform fusion splicing or mechanical splicing according to manufacturer guidelines. Secure the terminated fibers in the panel's splice tray or patch panel slots, ensuring no sharp bends and maintaining the minimum bend radius. Label each fiber for easy identification and future maintenance.

Testing and Documentation After installation, test each fiber for continuity, insertion loss, and signal quality using an optical power meter or OTDR. Document the install...
