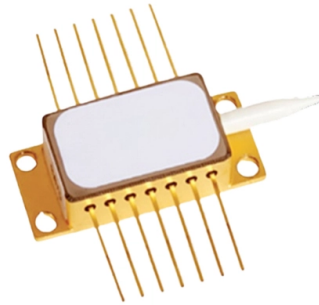


How to connect fiber optic cables and fiber optic distribution boxes
