

How to connect fiber optic cables and network panels

Open the patch panel door or module. Insert the fiber connector into the adapter or port, ensuring it clicks securely. Route the cable along the panel's cable management guides to prevent sharp bends; maintain the minimum bend radius specified by the manufacturer. Label each fiber connection clearly for future troubleshooting and network management.
