- Splicing:** Fusion splicing permanently joins two fibers by fusing them with heat, providing low-loss, high-reliability connections. Mechanical splicing can be used for temporary or less critical connections.
- Connector Termination:** Attach connectors (LC, SC, ST) compatible with network equipment. Ensure proper alignment and secure fit.
- Bend Radius and Pulling Limits:** Avoid sharp bends and excessive tension to prevent signal degradation.
